**Note: pretrial detainees subsequently sentenced to serve at HCDC will be reclassified and follow the flow outlined for the sentenced population*

Booked/Taken into Custody
- Proxy Screen (3 questions)

Classification/ Reclassification
- Assign counselor
- Initiate Reentry Checklist (LOS > 10 days)
- Reentry and LS/CMI Referrals

Pretrial Detention at HCDC*

Sentenced to serve at HCDC

Score > 4* or
Classification Referral,
LOS ≥ 60 days*

**Note: for LOS ≥ 30 but ≤ 60 days, HCDC will conduct LS/CMI and refer to interventions on an as needed basis*

T4C & Transition plans

Men: Volunteer basis (sentenced population given 1st priority); Women: open to all

Assessed with LS/CMI

LOS ≥ 60* days

Reentry Sessions (rolling enrollment)

CASE MANAGEMENT REVIEW
- Develop case plan
- Select interventions

Women: open to all

T4C open to all pretrial women
